Registration and Pit-Set Up

Team and Visitor registrations will take place on May 22 between 13:00 – 17:30 and on May 23 between 08:00-09:00.

For the registration desk, you will be expected to submit your 3 copies of your Team Information Sheet and Consent Form for every member and every coach/advisor.

After your team gets registered, our Volunteers will give you your Team Package in which you will find your name tags, tournament schedule, event schedule, and some surprise gifts that we hope you will enjoy.



The registrations for Visitors and Team Fans will be carried out on the same registration desk. They will also gather their name tags and the Welcome Package. For Free Pass Visitors/Team Fans, they may collect their name tag from the kiosk machines in the entrance area of the venue from the main door.

What you will see in the pit area:

When you enter the pit area, our Field Volunteers will help you find your booth.

- Team booths will be 5 meters X 5 meters that is 25 squaremeters.
- The height will also be 5 meters and the material will be chipboard with metal frame.
- The items reserved for teams will include:
- Name tags stating the name and the number of the team
- A table and chairs
- Type C Triple Socket
- A mini trash bin

The teams will be allowed to decorate their booths with soft materials. Use your imagination!

Team booth can not be covered by tents or similar materials due to the security reasons.

Judging



Judging Sessions

All the judging sessions will take place in Hall C, the rooms will be isolated from all the unwanted noise and allow the judges and the team interact in a healthy way. All the sessions will last for 12 minutes.

Core Values

• 2 min preparation + 2 min poster presentation + 5 min questions and preparation answers + 3 min team activity

Project

• 2 min preparation + 5 min presentation + 5 min questions and answers

Robot Design

• 12 min questions and answers by the tournament table (3-4 min optional representation at the beginning)

To be granted an award, a team is expected to attend every judging session and every robot game on their schedule.



To be the champion, a team should is expected to succeed in all three different categories and be within %40 among teams for the robot games performance.

The official language of the tournament will be English. Teams will be allowed to bring their translators if they would like so.


Judging

Core Values Poster

The teams will be expected to prepare their Core Values Poster in alliance with the values of FIRST LEGO League and reflect the processes of team has gone through in the season through it.

The dimensions of it should not exceed 90 cm X 120 cm.

- Discovery: What the team has discovered throughout the season and how did they balance all 3 parts of FIRST LEGO League.
- Integration: How have you incorporated the skills and ideas learned through the process to everyday life.
- Inclusion: How you considered everyone's ideas and made all team members feel valuable.
- Coopetition: How did you honor the spirit of friendly competition and did you help other teams?
- Other: Any other core values you want to highlight goes here.



Judging Call Backs

- ❖ We use the call-back system and there will be two call back sessions on May 24 and May 25. Each will last 7 minutes.
- For call back sessions, there will be 3 different rooms for each category be as you can see in the image below:



Therefore a team might be called back 9 times (3 rooms for 3 categories) and may not be called back once. The fact that your team is called back or not does not indicate that you will be winning an award or not.

You do not have to make a presentation except Project Room and you do not have to tell about your Core Values poster during call back sessions.




ROBOT GAMES

Robot Games will be in Hall B. There are 3 areas for Robot Games and Practices:

- Robot Practice Area: You will find Practice Tables in the middle of the Pit Area. You can reserve Practice Tables multiple times during the day for limited duration.
- Robot Game Area: You will find Robot Game Tables in this area. You will perform 2.5 minute Robot Games on these tables. There will be a trolley next to each table to be used as additional storage area.
- P Robot Control Desk: This desk is at the entrance of Robot Game Area. Your robot will be checked to see whether it is suitable for the match.

- 3 rounds on May 23 and 24
- 1 session for Just-For-Fun-Finals on May 25

- 10 Robot Game Tables
- 15 Practice Tables
- 5 Game Tables in the Robot Design Rooms

Following are some of the control points on Robot Control Desk. Your Robot is expected to comply with all of the rules.



- Max 12 inches" (30.5 cm) height for each launch
- Max ONE (1) controller
- Max FOUR (4) motors (combination of Medium & Large motors)
- Only LEGO-made parts in original factory condition



They both are incredibly excited to meet and take fun selfies with you at Open International Turkey 2019!








Venue - fuarizmir

Our venue fuarizmir is the biggest exhibition fair of fuar in Turkey. It renders its services on an area of 330,000 m² where fairs, congresses, seminars or event organizations are held. The tournament will take place in Hall B and Hall C.









There will be four special events in total that every team member and team coach/advisor and Full Pass visitors/Team Fans can enjoy apart from the Opening Ceremony on May 23 and the Award Ceremony on May 25.

For the Opening Ceremony, teams' seats will be reserved in advance and our volunteer team will help you out find your seats.


Friendship Night at İnciraltı City Forest

'Colours of Science' City Parade




May 23 - 18:00-19:00

May 24 - 19:00-21:00



Bergama and Ayvalık: A very well preserved antique city meets with the great nature of Ayvalık.

- Bergama-Ayvalık tour is not available as half day.

- The invoices regarding the registration payments can be purchased from the registration desk on May 22. The details we'd ask you for the invoice is on this form: https://forms.gle/GvMJ8yZ8o4szHcxR6
- There will be shuttle service on the first day of your arrival, during the tournament, and the day of your departure. Please do not forget to state your flight codes on the team registration system if you have not already. The timetable will be shared with all the teams on May 16.
- There will be a cafe, an ATM, an Exchange Office and WIFI connection will be available at the venue. You can have personaly a WIFI code through kiosk machine in the entrance.
- For the duration of the tournament, lunch time will be 12:00 14:00. Please check your schedule in case you have a robot game or judging session before taking your lunch time. And also, remember to wear your name tags for the whole tournament and the special events.
- For lost items, you can visit the coordination room in the venue.
- You will see bottles of water on your table of your team's booth. It will also be provided in the Hall B when you run out of it.
- İzmir at the end of May is quite warm (sometimes really hot). We advise you to bring light and comfortable clothes.
- There will be medical assistance team in fuarizmir and all events areas. You can conctact with coordination team if you need any assistance.

Safety Rules

- Due the safety reasons and emergency fire sprinkles above, it is not allowed to cover the top of the team booths with fabric or any material in the pit area.
- If you need any medical assistance, we kindly ask you to contact with crew members or field volunteers. We will 2 ambulances ready for medical assistance at all times during the tournament and the special events.
- In case of emergency, we will be using the emergency exits on the East part of the Hall B, the main entrance or back entrance doors.
- It is strictly forbidden to bring any hot beverages in pit area and the robot games area.
- During the events and at the end of each day we recommend coaches, advisors and parents to always to keep an eye on the kids and the young people, since the areas of some special events will take place in quite large areas of the city.
